RE: Proposed Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws concerning Synod Frequency

Dear Delegates:

I write to bring you up to date on the status of the Proposed Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws that will be presented at General Synod. The Unified Board met, via telephone conference, on May 21, 2015 and after considerable discussion, voted to withdraw the package of proposed Amendments that concern the frequency with which General Synod is held from consideration by the 30th General Synod. The sections of the proposed amendments that concerns are those sections that were highlighted in "yellow" on the original posting on the General Synod website.

So that you will not need to be concerned that these proposed amendments are not completely withdraw, or confused by what is being presented, we have asked that the posted copy of the proposed Amendments be corrected to remove the package that is being withdrawn, i.e. those relating to Synod Frequency, highlighted in "yellow." As this was a group of proposed Amendments that was separate and distinct from the two other proposed packages, there is no change or modification of what you are being asked to consider in the two packages of proposed amendments that will be presented.

I look forward to seeing you all at General Synod.
