9	TEXT OF THE MOTION

11	WHEREAS: The Nineteenth General Synod adopted the "Statement of Christian Conviction of
12	the Proposed Pronouncement Calling the United Church of Christ to be a Multiracial and
13	Multicultural Church," and
14	
15	WHEREAS: the Samoan churches have been related to COREM through PAAM from its
16	inception, and
17	
18	WHEREAS: PAAM's 16 ethnicities have always been hospitable and inclusive of their Samoan
19	partners, nevertheless, Samoans feel they have sufficiently unique needs and experiences to have
20	a separate voice in COREM, and
21 22	WHEREAS, Southarn California DAAM has noted to support this request
22	WHEREAS: Southern California PAAM has voted to support this request.
23 24	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Twenty-ninth General Synod of the United Church of
25	Christ recognizes that the five streams of Samoan ministries have been historically
26	underrepresented in the United Church of Christ.
27	underrepresented in the emited church of emist.
28	LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Twenty-ninth General Synod supports the creation
29	of the United Samoan Ministries as an Historically Underrepresented Group of the United
30	Church of Christ.
31	LET IT BE FINALLY RESOLVED that the Executive Council (or its successor body) consider
32	a change in bylaws that would grant the United Samoan Ministries a seat at the Council for
33	Racial and Ethnic Ministries (COREM) table.

35	FUNDING

37	Funding for the implementation of the resolution will be made in accordance with the overall
38	mandates of the affected agencies and the funds available.
